# Ellen Buchanan Children's Room Dedicated

On Saturday, Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Library held a special celebration to dedicate the Ellen Buchanan Children's Room and unveil the beautiful and newly-completed mosaic art entryway and slide. Ellen and John Buchanan and their grandchildren were the official ribbon-cutters and area families took part in stories and crafts about creativity and the arts.

Designed, created, and installed by Cedar Rapids artist Karla McGrail, the Children's Room mosaic features thousands of small cut tile pieces, which emphasize the main colors of our interior design and form familiar images that children can search for and explore. Some images are childlike, such as a book, teddy bear, bicycle, or soccer ball. Others include letters and pictograms from various

alphabets and languages—including Arabic, Chinese, Vietnamese, and English. Then there are images actually taken from Iowa and Iowa City, like the Old Capitol building and the new Iowa quarter. As you walk into the area, be sure to look above you to see several constellations (the Big & Little Dippers). Both children and adults are invited to measure themselves against the six-foot tall corn plant each time they visit.

A free coloring and scavenger hunt sheet is available to help you and your children explore and find all the objects hidden in the wonderful mosaic of the Ellen Buchanan Children's Room. Ask for one today and have fun while you
