Johnson County Men in the War of 1917-1918



THIS illustrated booklet contains a complete list of the soldiers and sailors from Johnson county who served in the United States army and navy during the great war of 1917-1918, so far as such list can be compiled at this time. It is the same list that has been filed with the war department at Washington, D. C. and was compiled from the records of the Johnson County Exemption Board and the Iowa City Commercial Club. We hope that no errors or omissions will be found, but at this time it is not possible to be confident that the list is absolutely correct in every particular.

By waiting until a later period, when the men have all been demobilized, it would then be possible to give a more accurate check of the list, but the people of the county will be interested in securing this booklet at as early a date as possible.

We believe it would be impossible now to secure as complete a list of pictures of the men who went under the selective service act as we have presented here. From the beginning of the operation of the law The Citizen secured photographs of each group as the men went out and we think this is the only complete set of such pictures. There were individuals called at different periods but we have included all the larger groups.

It has been the desire of The Citizen to issue a booklet which would be worthy of preservation by every family in Johnson county, and we are fortunate in being able to present these pictures of all of the larger groups of men who went out under the selective service law as well as other photographs of interest. In some small way we hope this will be taken as a tribute to the valor and the sacrifice of the men who represented this county in the great war.






