

On October 14, 1923 in the Sunday School rooms of the church was held a joint meeting of all the Church officers at 3 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by Rev. Reed after which he stated briefly the object of the meeting as follows: that since the Presbyterian Board of Education were going to put on a Campaign for Funds in February might it not be better to consider a larger program and raise a larger sum of money and invest in property upon which to locate a new Church, Synod-house and Manse.

After considerable discussion a motion was made and carried that a committee of three be appointed from the Board of Trustees to sound out the sentiment of the State University authorities in regard to buying the Church property and report such information at a meeting of all the Church officers in several weeks.

Meeting adjourned.

Meeting of Church officers Sunday, Nov. 25th, 1923. The meeting was called to order by the Rev. Reed. Upon a motion Rev. Reed was elected Chairman of the meeting. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Judge Byington reported that Mr. Mercer, Dr. Bywater and himself had interviewed the President of the University and presented the situation of the church people. Later President Jessup presented the matter at a Board meeting and reported that they were ready to take over the Church property if the congregation so wished and would probably do so by condemning the property.

A motion was made that a committee investigate about locations and properties and make a definite recommendation to the Church officers at a later meeting. Carried.

A motion was made that the chair appoint a committee of which he himself be the Chairman to see Miss Hess about securing her property for Church purposes. Carried.
