After considerable discussion as to what might be the best thing to do in regard to securing property for Church buildings and a Student Center Mr. Fitzgerald made a motion that the Church Officers recommend to the congregation that they go out in February 1924 to raise \$ 50,000.00 . \$15,000.00 to be used for Student work and \$ 35,000.00 ^{toward} ~~for~~ a new church and if we fall short of the total amount the basis of division be as 15 to 30. (30 and 70 %) . Carried.

The additional \$ 5,000.00 to make up the \$ 20,000.00 which was apportioned to Iowa City to raise is to be suscribed by the students.
